2003 **BLACKLIP** Port Lincoln Shiraz

COLOUR:

Deep purple / red colour

NOSE:

Very attractive aromas of ripe satsuma plums, black pepper and star anise, intermingled with vanilla and mocha characters derived from the oak - plenty going on here.

PALATE:

*The palate displays similar characters as the aroma with eastern spices dominating the flavour profile as well as some lovely soft, plummy fruit balancing the oak, acid and tannins of the wine.
Quite concentrated really.*

ALCOHOL:

15.0%
